# **Corporate Pursuit**

## Normal Christian life

- Call on the name of the Lord @8AM on LD corporately and pray-read one verse
- Enjoy the Lord Jesus Christ! Keep a **personal time** with the Lord daily.
- Every sister has a **vital companion**
- Redeem the time by **praying**, **reading** the Word, and **praising** Him!
- Any worldly entertainment, such as movies, dramas, comedies, TV shows, pop music, that may affect the spiritual atmosphere is NOT allowed within this Sister's House (SH)
- Corporate **night-time prayer** everyday before sleep

# Lord's Day

- All sisters will **sanctify every Lord's Day** to attend Lord's Table meeting.
- Gospel-preaching in LD afternoon two by two is strongly encouraged.

# Hosting meetings

- All sisters **should be at home** except for very special cases
- All sisters should pray for the meeting, clean the house, preparing the meal, and labor together

# SH Weekly Fellowship Time

- Everyone must attend and positively support the weekly fellowship time on Friday mornings @9:00AM
- Pray, share, fellowship and re-consecrate for the Sisters' House
- Be open to fellowship with your roommates regarding room issues
- Fellowship weekly chores, home accounting, hospitality, and rules-keeping

# **Corporate Living Guidelines**

# Morning Revival

- Every sister must have at least one vital companion for morning revival every day Visitors
  - Members of the opposite sex are **not allowed**, with the following exceptions:
    - (1) family members (allowed to stay during the day-time only);
    - o (2) with the covering of a married couple;
    - (3) during home meetings.
  - Friends or gospel friends—inform every sister ahead of time
  - Overnight guests— fellowshipped with all the sisters living in the house

# Hospitality

 Everyone should share the burden in taking care of hospitality, before, during and after each visit.

## Alcohol

• No alcohol in the sisters' house

### Rent and utilities

- Rent should be submitted to the person who collects the money by the 27th of each month. No one should have to be reminded
- Everyone is responsible for a full year's rent according to the terms and dates of the lease, including during school breaks and the summer.
- In the unforeseen event of needing to move out, you are responsible for the full rent until the other sisters can find someone else to move in and replace you.
- Remind the incoming sister to submit a deposit of the 3-month rent and the 1st month rent before the move in date, and must sign the "Sisters' House Agreement".

# Cleaning Schedule

- Each sister will take one or two assigned section(s) and rotate each week.
- No dishes/utensils should be left after the meal; No kitchenware should be left in a mess, clean the kitchen right after cooking
- No trash overnight, the housemom and the last one going to sleep should take out trash. Remind each other to take the trash out whenever you see it's more than half-full
- Corporate cleaning time: Friday after fellowship
- All areas, including your personal areas should be maintained tidy at all times.
- If you are foreseeing that you may leave the house for a certain days or months temporarily, you need to fellowship and make sure that the duties are covered.

### Curfew

- If you can not make it back to the house before midnight, let someone know
- Lights-out by 11:30PM

#### Bathroom

- Keep the bathroom door unlocked while you are in shower so others can share
- Only lock the door when using the toilet or getting dressed. Leave the door unlocked in all other circumstances (in shower, brushing teeth, etc.)

# Downloading

- No downloading of pirated software/games/movies nor of any sexually explicit or pornographic material.
- Any worldly entertainment, such as movies, dramas, comedies, TV shows, pop music, that may affect the spiritual atmosphere is NOT allowed within this SH

#### Roommates

- Computer usage/gaming—Please be respectful of your roommate at all times, especially after midnight. Use headphones at all times.
- Please restrict your personal usage of the dining table within a meal's time (1hr)
- No personal items left in common areas, especially the dining table
- No murmurings nor reasonings;
- Always fellowship; No one should make decisions for the household without fellowship and majority agreement.

Minimum number of church meetings per week: **two**. The Lord's Table plus at least one other meeting. Optional meetings: Tuesday prayer meeting, home meetings, Friday campus meeting, small group meeting

## Housemom

- Supervise the abiding of each rule
- Gather everyone for corporate fellowship of that week
- Remind sisters to maintain their personal space organized and clean
- Personal space includes desks, areas under and around the desks, walls, beds, areas around beds, closets, bedroom floor
- Hallway mirror, lamps, shoe closet, foyer closet
- Keep the record regarding rule-breaking and important fellowship

# **Weekly Chores**

**Be considerate for others.** Please **clean up after yourself**. Do not leave a mess, even if it's not your assigned area. Please maintain your assigned house section(s) **in a daily basis**, as well as **keeping your personal spaces clean**. Please **take the trash out** when you see it's half-full, and replace a trash bag.

## Hallway

- Keep shoes orderly on or by the shoe racks
- Keep the entrance foyer organized and clean
- Sweep and mop the foyer and hallway ground daily (including kitchen)

## Livingroom (Housemom)

- Reminding others to wipe the dining table after usage and keep their desks organized
- Keep the bookshelves, chairs, drying racks organized, neat, and tidy
- Keep the power cords organized and tidy
- Sweep and mop the livingroom floor as needed

## Kitchen I

- Remind sisters to do their own dishes.
- Put away the dishes from the dish rack to its designated place
- Wipe stove area and keep counters clean
- Pick up the garbage and clean the mess from the kitchen ground after usage
- Clean the sink and dump the garbage from the filter

## Kitchen II

- Wipe the refrigerator door, cabinet door, and microwave
- Wipe the walls (above the sink, stove, and by the trashcans)
- Keep the foodstuff organized on the shelves and food racks clean
- Throw out stale food

#### Bathroom

- Keep the bathtub clean and tidy after usage so that the next sister using the bathroom could enjoy the same environment as you did.
- Remember to clean up the filter after shower to the trash can
- Keep the floor free of water and **hair** after usage
- Put away your clothes and towels after usage
- Keep the mirror, cabinet wall and toilet free of stains
- Keep the sink, its surroundings, and soap holder free of water, hair and stains
- Keep the rugs dry and tidy
