# Announcement of 2017 Chinese-Speaking Students' Perfecting Training

We praise the Lord for His blessing on the labor among the Chinese-speaking students in the past thirteen years. With the cooperation of the local churches, more than ten thousand students have been saved and baptized in North America during this period of time and have come into the church life in various degrees. According to Brother Lee's fellowship and leading in *Elders' Training*, Book 4, Chapter 10, we have been holding an annual one-week perfecting training to perfect these newly-saved ones in the aspects of truth, life, vision, and service.

In order to carry out this burden to produce these students as useful members of the Body, we feel that our perfecting of them should go a step further, especially for those who were small group leaders in the past perfecting trainings, those who are currently active on the campuses, or students who have demonstrated a strong desire to pursue and serve the Lord. Therefore, as we practiced in the past years, we will:

- 1. Encourage these students to attend the summer training in Anaheim.
- 2. Gather together any of these students who are able to remain in Southern California after the summer training from July 9 to 12 for a time of prayer and fellowship in preparation for the perfecting training. However, these students will need a recommendation from their local elders.

The annual Chinese-speaking students' perfecting training will be held in Kingston Penuel Christian Center, NY from July 21 to July 28. The first three days, from the 21<sup>st</sup> to the 23<sup>rd</sup>, will be for the serving ones, and then the rest of the week, from the 24<sup>th</sup> to the 28<sup>th</sup>, will be for the students. As in the past, we encourage the churches or clusters of churches to carry out weekend extension trainings in other areas in North America.

We welcome any blending co-workers who have the burden and time to come to these trainings to perfect the serving ones and students.

We hope you will pray concerning this burden and encourage the local Chinese-speaking students and their serving ones to register for these trainings. If the elders feel that anyone in their locality is not suitable for participation in this training due to their spiritual or physical condition, please let us know, as this will help us in our review of the applications.
